

Danish architecture office CEBRA won the competition to design a new landmark in the capital of Albania, Tirana. Located on a prominent plot in the very heart of the city, the project is an architectural piece that celebrates the national identity and cultural heritage of Albania. Measuring 205 meters **Mount Tirana** will be the tallest building in the country, a distinctive tower inspired by the beauty of Albania and the impressive mountains that surround the capital. Mount Tirana comprises housing, commercial facilities, boutique hotel, offices, parking facilities, and all the necessary amenities like restaurants and cafes. The project will be constructed using locally sourced materials to minimize the building's carbon footprint. The generous terraces on the mountain slope also help reduce the need for mechanical cooling and aid the urban biodiversity.
